WHAT: **Houston SPCA** team members have just returned this afternoon from the Louisiana SPCA after a week of long days and evenings managing shelter operations including triage, cleaning and feeding as well as assisting with transports and lifesaving tasks after the shelter was heavily impacted by Hurricane Ida.

The team brought back a trio of puppies who will find new homes right here in Houston, as well as 25 cats who will finish their journey to Austin.

The **Houston SPCA** team left last Wednesday with loads of supplies loads of supplies including box fans, food and cases of bottled water for Louisiana SPCA staff members along with 2800 pounds of Hill's Science Diet dog and cat food for their shelter pets.

The **Houston SPCA** provided a safe haven for 138 dogs, cats and kittens from Louisiana shelters last Saturday, while some of the pets continued on to San Antonio and Austin. Many of those pets are available for [adoption at the Houston SPCA.](#)
