## Emergency Rescue in North Houston: 10 Emaciated Dogs, 9 Puppies and a Kitten

(HOUSTON) December 13, 2022 – Houston SPCA Animal Cruelty Investigations team and Harris County Constable Precinct 1 conducted an emergency rescue for 10 emaciated dogs, nine puppies and a kitten yesterday near the 3,000 block of Havner Lane in north Houston.



Several of the emaciated dogs were tethered by chains in the front yard of the property while the puppies, a kitten and remaining dogs were roaming free. All were lacking adequate food, water or veterinary care.

All twenty animals were promptly removed from the property and are now receiving individualized medical treatment from Houston SPCA veterinary staff.

The owner could face up to two years in prison and a \$10,000 fine for animal cruelty. The Houston SPCA's 10-member animal cruelty investigations team works very closely with local law enforcement in and around the greater Houston area to end cruelty including HPD, Harris County Constable Precinct 1 and nine other surrounding Texas counties.
