### Seven Puppies, Two Dogs Rescued from Home After Video Captures Six-Week-Old Kitten on Fire

**HOUSTON (June 6, 2024)** – The Houston SPCA and Harris County Constable Precinct 1 rescued nine dogs including seven puppies this afternoon after officials said a kitten from the same home near the 12,000 block of Drifting Winds was set on fire overnight. Officials



state surveillance video captured the tiny kitten running while she was engulfed in flames. The kitten taken into the care of the Houston SPCA Animal Hospital this morning and was humanely euthanized due to the burns and internal injuries.

Officials at the scene said the dogs were emaciated and did not have access to food or water. The puppies were kept in dirty wire kennels inside a storage shed. Harris County Constable Precinct 1 served a civil seizure warrant that allowed the dogs to be removed from the property. The investigation is currently ongoing. A hearing for custody of the dogs will be held next week.
