



Founding in 1924

The Houston SPCA was established by a group of community leaders — and dedicated animal lovers — to address the critical needs of animals in the community.





Launch of the Animal **Cruelty Investigations team** (1930-1940)

Our team formed to address urgent needs in our community and got to work rescuing cats, dogs, and horses from cruelty. Thanks to donor contributions, we rescued countless animals from abuse and neglect, leading the way in animal welfare in our region.



Establishment of the Houston SPCA's Wildlife Center of Texas (2007)

With financial backing from supporters, the Houston SPCA expanded its mission to include native wildlife. This center has provided care and rehabilitation for thousands of injured or orphaned wild

animals — more than 360 species!

Creation of 24/7 Animal Rescue Ambulance Service (1960s)

Donor support paved the way for the city's first dedicated animal ambulance service. This mobile unit has provided round-the-clock rapid response and on-site care for animals in emergency situations across the Greater Houston Area.



Opening of the First Dedicated Animal Shelter (1950s)

Thanks to generous donations, the Houston SPCA opened its first purpose-built animal shelter. This milestone greatly expanded our capacity to care for animals and marked a new era of growth.



Construction of Our Stateof-the-Art Campus (2018)

A major fundraising campaign, powered by donor generosity, allowed for constructing a modern, comprehensive animal care campus. This eight-building, 12-acre facility dramatically improved the Houston SPCA's ability to serve animals and the community.

Build Me Up Buttercup: A Rescue Story

he news was shocking. "A local man faces felony animal cruelty charges after being caught on camera abusing a puppy in a northwest Houston cell phone store."

A cruelty report was filed, and we partnered with Harris County Constable Precinct 1 to rescue the pup: Buttercup.

While Buttercup didn't sustain significant injuries, Dr. Westbrook, our chief animal welfare officer, warned that continued abuse could have led to severe harm or death. Meanwhile, the suspect awaits arraignment and could face jail time and fines for his actions.

This case highlights the ongoing need to combat animal cruelty in our region. Countless animals still suffer unreported abuse daily. We must intensify efforts to educate the public, strengthen protection laws, and improve cruelty reporting systems.

Your support is crucial in rescuing animals like Buttercup and working toward a cruelty-free future. Together, we can build a community that values and protects all animals from abuse and neglect.

Wildlife Center Responds to Storm Crisis



fter a big storm hit Houston in May and then Hurricane Beryl impacted the city in July, more than 2,000 native wildlife were left orphaned or injured in the Greater Houston Area. But thanks to the generous support of our donors, our Wildlife Center sprang into action, providing critical care to a variety of wildlife, including songbirds, raptors, yellow-crowned night herons, and even a bald eagle.

Your donations allow us to offer immediate response and specialized care in times of crisis. Our dedicated team works tirelessly to rehabilitate these animals and release them back into their natural habitats once they recover.
