They can also review the nonprofit's website to read their mission statement and see the various ways they can give back to the organization or get involved if they cannot make a financial contribution. It's also a good idea to check social media accounts to ensure they align with your values and interests.

Giving Tuesday is strategically placed at the beginning of the holiday season as a reminder to communities that so many charities rely on their support to make an impact on services like the Houston SPCA which provide animals in need with veterinary services, animal cruelty investigations, 24-hour rescue ambulance and more.
