Dog in Stable Condition After Getting Shot in Northwest Houston

HOUSTON (January 28, 2025) — The Houston SPCA rescued a three-year-old dog near the 3500 block of East TC Jester in northwest Houston after she was shot on January 17. The Houston SPCA's animal ambulance found the husky mix bleeding with multiple open wounds.

A single bullet pierced her chest and exited her left side before striking her left front limb. Thankfully, the dog is now in stable condition and is receiving veterinary care at the Houston SPCA's hospital.

Houston Police Department is investigating the incident.
