Houston SPCA Rescued 15 Dogs from Inside Deplorable Home in Southwest Houston

Dogs Were Found Matted, Cruelly Confined Inside the Home Filled with Urine and Feces

HOUSTON (March 18, 2025) – The Houston SPCA rescued 15 dogs from a home located near the 12,000 block of Dairy Brook Drive in Southwest Houston. The animals were discovered living in deplorable conditions with debris, urine and feces. The owner of the property signed over the dogs to the Houston SPCA where are now receiving individualized care.





Officials at the scene said the dogs, found matted, dirty, and cruelly confined, were suffering from the effects of hoarding. Veterinary staff from the Houston SPCA along with their veterinary students from Texas A&M are assessing each dog for immediate health concerns and needs.

This rescue should serve as a reminder of the dire, ongoing need in the greater Houston area for awareness and action against animal hoarding and cruelty.
