Houston SPCA Named Best Nonprofit

Animal Rescue and Protection Organization Voted 'Best of the Best' Nonprofit Through Online Voting for Third Consecutive Year

HOUSTON (July 18, 2025) – The Houston SPCA was named Houston's Best of the Best in the nonprofit category at an awards ceremony held at POST this week after several rounds of online voting that were open to the public earlier this Spring.



The Houston Chronicle's Best of the Best 2025 categories included Beauty, Eat and Drink, Entertainment and Leisure, Health and Fitness, Home Services and Finance, Kids and Education and Legal as well as Retail and Services.

The Houston SPCA has been serving the greater Houston area and beyond for more than 100 years and is now one of the country's most comprehensive animal welfare organizations with more than a dozen programs and services including their 9-member, full-time animal cruelty investigations team serving nine Texas counties; the only 24-hour injured animal ambulance in the region and the Houston SPCA's Wildlife Center, one of the largest wildlife rehabilitation centers in the nation that cares for more than 16,000 native wildlife annually.
