## Two Dogs Shot; Man Charged with Animal Cruelty

HOUSTON (Sept. 11, 2025) — Six dogs were rescued by the Houston SPCA's Animal Rescue Ambulance following reports of shots being fired at an apartment complex in southwest Harris County late Monday night. At the scene, two of the dogs were found suffering from several gunshot wounds. All six dogs were transported by the Houston SPCA Animal Ambulance to their animal hospital for immediate treatment and evaluation.



"One dog has multiple fractures; the other has a broken ulna. Both have gunshot wounds with entry and exit points," said Dr. Roberta Westbrook, Senior VP of Veterinary Medicine at the Houston SPCA. Westbrook adds that both dogs are stable and in good condition.

Officials with <u>Harris County Constable Precinct 1</u> said Oscar Junior Johnson, 54, was arrested and charged with Felon in Possession of a Firearm and two felony counts of Cruelty to a Non-Livestock Animal after witnesses reported he was seen discharging a firearm toward the dogs.
